

Minor in Economics

This specialization introduces students to economics. They choose 3-5 courses from a list of ~15 Bachelor courses offered by the Sorbonne School of Economics (from year 1 to 3) for 18 ECTS.

Prerequisites: a B2 level in French language, as well as a appetite for mathematics, and even a solid background in mathematics if students plan to take the more advanced courses.
