

Minor in Economics

Description of the Specialization (minor):

This specialization introduces students to economics. They choose 3-5 courses from a list of 15 Bachelor courses offered by the Sorbonne School of Economics (from year 1 to 3) for 18 ECTS.

Courses mostly take place at Centre Pierre Mendès France, 90 rue de Tolbiac, Paris 13.

Important prerequisites: a B2 level in French language, as well as an appetence for mathematics, and even a solid background in mathematics if students plan to take the more advanced courses.
